

BENGALURU INFINITY RUN

TERMS & CONDITIONS, PARTICIPANT WAIVER & RELEASE

1. Registration

Registration is confirmed only after successful payment and receipt of registration confirmation. Participants must provide accurate personal, contact, emergency-contact, and other required information.

2. Age Eligibility & Categories

3 KM Fun Run – 12+ Years

Participants must be 12 years or above.

Participants aged 12 to 16 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.

Both the child and accompanying parent/guardian must register separately and possess valid event registrations/bibs.

5 KM Timed Run – 16+ Years

Participants must be 16 years or above on the event date.

10 KM Timed Run – 18+ Years

Participants must be 18 years or above on the event date.

Half Marathon – 18+ Years

Participants must be 18 years or above. Participants must have successfully completed at least one timed running event within the previous 10 months. The organizer may request official race results, certificates, timing records, or other proof of participation. Failure to provide satisfactory proof may result in cancellation of the Half Marathon entry or transfer to another eligible category, subject to the organizer's decision.

3. Bib Collection

Participants must collect their bib within the announced bib-distribution period. Bibs will generally not be issued on race day unless specifically announced by the organizer.

4. Bib Transfer

Bibs are non-transferable unless an official transfer is permitted by the organizer. Running with another participant's bib may result in disqualification.

5. Category Participation

Participants must participate only in the category for which they have registered. Changing categories without prior approval from the organizer may result in disqualification or non-recording of results.

6. Timing & Results

Timed categories will be recorded using the event's designated timing system. Participants must wear their assigned timing bib/chip correctly. Final results will be subject to verification by the organizer and timing team.

7. Prize Money & Cash Rewards

Where applicable, prize money or cash rewards will be awarded based on the published eligibility criteria and verified official results. Eligible winners will receive their cash reward within **7 working days after the event**, subject to completion of result verification and submission of the required bank account/payment details and supporting documents. The cash reward will be credited to the eligible winner's **registered bank account**. Any applicable taxes, deductions, or statutory requirements shall be dealt with in accordance with applicable law. The organizer reserves the right to withhold or delay payment where results are under verification, required documents or bank details have not been provided, or there is any dispute regarding eligibility or results.

8. Refund & Cancellation Policy

Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable, unless otherwise specifically announced by the organizer. Participants who register but do not attend the event, fail to collect their bib, arrive after the race start, or are unable to

participate for personal reasons will not be eligible for a refund.

9. Event Cancellation/Postponement

The organizer reserves the right to cancel, postpone, reschedule, suspend, or modify the event due to adverse weather, natural disasters, government restrictions, traffic or police requirements, public safety concerns, insufficient permissions, force majeure, or any other circumstances beyond the organizer's reasonable control. In case of cancellation or postponement, the organizer will communicate the applicable refund, transfer, or rescheduling policy based on the circumstances and operational requirements.

10. Weather & Safety

The event may be delayed, shortened, rerouted, suspended, or cancelled if weather or other conditions are considered unsafe by the organizer, medical team, police, or relevant authorities.

11. Route & Operational Changes

The organizer reserves the right to change the race route, start/finish location, reporting time, flag-off time, categories, facilities, or other event arrangements due to safety, traffic, government/police directions, permissions, weather, or operational requirements.

12. Medical Fitness

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are physically fit and medically capable of participating in the selected category. Participants with medical concerns are advised to consult a qualified medical professional before participating.

13. Medical Emergency

First-aid and emergency medical assistance will be available at designated locations. In case of an emergency, the organizer or medical team may arrange appropriate medical assistance or transportation where reasonably possible. Any further medical treatment and associated expenses will be the participant's responsibility, subject to applicable insurance/event coverage.

14. Participant Waiver, Assumption of Risk & Release of Liability

By registering for and participating in the Bengaluru Infinity Run, the participant acknowledges and agrees that running and participation in an organized sporting event involve inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury, illness, accidents, falls, collisions, traffic-related incidents, adverse weather conditions, dehydration, fatigue, medical emergencies, and other unforeseen circumstances.

The participant voluntarily assumes all risks associated with participation in the event and confirms that they are participating at their own risk and responsibility.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, the participant agrees to release and hold harmless the event organizer, event management team, sponsors, partners, venue partners, volunteers, race officials, medical personnel, timing service providers, government and regulatory authorities, and their respective representatives, employees, and agents from claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, or expenses arising from or relating to the participant's participation in the event, except to the extent caused by proven negligence or wilful misconduct that cannot lawfully be excluded.

The participant understands that the organizer does not guarantee that participation will be free from injury, illness, accident, or other risk.

The participant confirms that all information provided during registration is accurate and agrees to immediately inform the organizer or medical team of any medical condition, injury, or circumstance that may affect their ability to safely participate.

In the event of a medical emergency, the participant authorizes the event's medical team or authorized personnel to provide or arrange reasonable first aid, emergency assistance, transportation, or medical care where considered necessary. The participant understands that any further medical treatment and associated expenses shall be their responsibility, subject to applicable insurance or event coverage.

For participants below 18 years of age, the parent or legal guardian confirms acceptance of these terms and assumes responsibility for the minor's participation, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

15. Participant Safety & Conduct

Participants must follow instructions from race officials, volunteers, medical personnel, traffic marshals, police, and other authorized personnel. Unsafe conduct, abusive behaviour, cheating, shortcutting the route, obstruction of other participants, or violation of event rules may result in immediate disqualification or removal from the event.

16. Disqualification

The organizer reserves the right to disqualify a participant for:

- Using another participant's bib
- Unauthorized bib transfer
- Taking shortcuts or deviating from the official route
- Providing incorrect age or registration information
- Failing to meet category eligibility requirements
- Unsportsmanlike or unsafe conduct
- Tampering with timing equipment
- Violating instructions from event officials

No refund will be provided following disqualification.

17. Race Kit & Event Inclusions

T-shirts, medals, bibs, refreshments, hydration, certificates, timing services, and other event inclusions will be provided according to the participant's registered category and the event package communicated by the organizer.

18. Photography & Media Consent

Participants acknowledge that photographs, videos, and other recordings may be taken during the event. By registering, participants provide consent for the organizer and its partners to use such content for promotional, marketing, social-media, advertising, and future event-related purposes.

19. Minors

For participants below 18 years, the parent/guardian accompanying the participant must accept responsibility for the minor's participation and comply with all applicable consent requirements. For the 3 KM Fun Run, participants aged 12–16 must be accompanied by a registered parent/guardian throughout the event.

20. Force Majeure

The organizer shall not be liable for failure, delay, cancellation, postponement, or modification of the event caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, extreme weather, epidemics/pandemics, government orders, strikes, civil disturbances, security threats, or other force majeure events.

21. Organizer's Rights

The organizer reserves the right to make final decisions regarding participant eligibility, category allocation, route, timings, results, disqualification, prizes, event facilities, postponement, cancellation, and other operational matters, subject to applicable law.

22. Acceptance of Terms

By completing registration, the participant confirms that they have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms & Conditions, event rules, safety requirements, waiver provisions, and applicable instructions issued by the organizer.
